Section II Description and scope of services. Obligations of service provider.

The subject of this procedure is the provision of simultaneous interpretation and technical services for a transnational event organised within the above-mentioned project.

The event will take place in Krakow, Poland, on 29 October 2026 and will gather representatives of trade unions and social partners participating in the FairForward project.

The service shall include:

Lot 1 – Interpretation Services

- Simultaneous interpretation services in the following languages:
 - English (EN)
 - Italian (IT)
 - Polish (PL)
 - Lithuanian (LT)
 - Serbian (RS)
 - Spanish (ES)
- Provision of 10 professional interpreters for the duration of the one-day event;

Lot 2 – Interpretation Booths and Equipment

- Provision of 5 interpretation booths fully equipped in accordance with international conference standards;
- Provision of interpretation equipment, receivers, microphones and all related technical infrastructure required for multilingual communication;
- Interpretation coordination services.

Lot 3 – Technical Event Services



- Technical assistance throughout the event;
- Conference platform operation;
- On-site registration management;
- Video recording of the event sessions;
- Live streaming services for remote participants.

The service provider shall ensure high-quality interpretation services, professional technical support, uninterrupted operation of all equipment, and effective coordination of the event's multilingual communication requirements.

The provider shall be responsible for all equipment, staffing, technical infrastructure and operational arrangements necessary for the successful delivery of the services.

Service providers may submit offers for:

- Lot 1 only;
- Lot 2 only;
- Lot 3 online
- Any combination of the above lots;
- All lots combined.

Partial offers are therefore permitted.

The Contracting Authority reserves the right to award separate contracts for different components of the service where this is considered more advantageous in terms of quality, expertise or value for money.

Section III Term of services

The service provider is expected to respect the following deadlines:

- The offer shall not require a prepayment
- The invoice for the services shall be issued within 14 days from completion of the service.
- The time limit for payment of the invoice must not be shorter than 30 days
