Section II Description and scope of services. Obligations of service provider.

The subject of this procedure is the provision of expert services supporting the implementation of Work Package 3 - European Social Dialogue and Policy Co-Creation for Modern Work, within the SSD project.

The service shall include:

● Preparation and delivery of Joint Policy Recommendations and Roadmap of Social Dialogue for Better Flexible and Platform Work in Europe and Policy Report: “Social Dialogue for New Work Models” (about 45 pages, approximately 67,500 characters, in English) in the period February – April 2027

The contractor shall ensure high-quality implementation of all activities, timely delivery of outputs, professional facilitation of service and compliance with the objectives and requirements of the SSD project.

The assignment is expected to be implemented between February 2027 and April 2027.



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Section III Term of services

The service provider is expected to respect the following deadlines:

- The offer shall not require a prepayment
- The invoice shall be issued within 30 days from completion and delivery of the service.
